THE YACHT

Built in 1990 by the world renowned Dutch shipyard Feadship, Blu 470 measures 49.68 metres with a beam of 8.69 metres, a draft of 2.92 metres and a volume of 478 GT.

The motor yacht's classic exterior design and naval architecture is the work of De Voogt Naval Architects and follows the same classic lines that make her Dutch sisterships so distinguishable. Her blue hull adds a touch of class to her sophisticated design, setting Blu 470

apart from the usual all-white superyachts cruising the seven seas.

Built for long ocean crossings, Blu 470 is as comfortable as any other with her built-in stabilisers and a durable steel displacement hull. Equipped with twin CAT diesel engines, she boasts an impressive range of 5,700 nm, offering yacht charter guests a comfortable cruising experience at 12 knots.
