THE EXPERIENCE

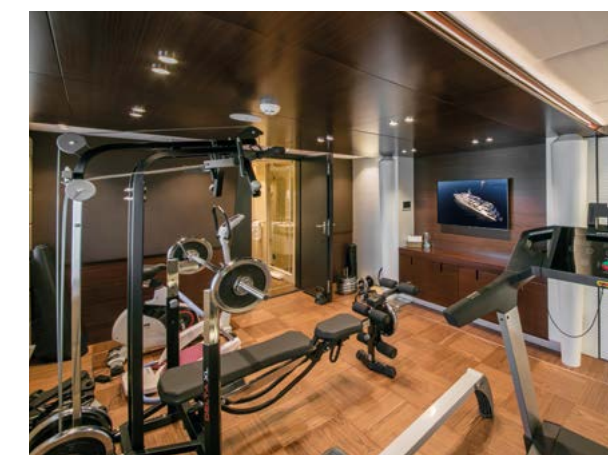

Captain Antonio Koludrovic explains: "Our crew is fully Croatian, the boat was built in Croatia, and we are experts in exploring the Croatian coast. Using our knowledge of the area, we always deliver an extraordinary charter experience, taking our guests to the best unexplored bays with peaceful and untouched nature."

Designed for comfortable cruising, this 1,212 GT motor yacht offers the deck space and amenities that few other yachts in her class can. The sun deck is designed for outdoor entertaining with an impressive 16 guest dining table and on deck bar setup, while during the day, this becomes the prime chillout zone as guests relax beside Katina's jacuzzi.

Accommodating up to 12 guests, each cabin can be converted into double or twin arrangements, with the 40 square metre VIP guest suites on the upper deck coming with their own fold-down balconies.

The spacious full beam master suite on the main deck benefits from spectacular panoramic views through the forward facing windows, guaranteeing a sensational start to each day.



THE CUISINE

When it comes to cuisine, guests aboard Katina can expect a truly authentic Croatian experience, with Chef Mario Kamenar proficient in catering to all tastes and food

preferences. With a strong restaurant background, and hailing from Istria which is famous for its truffle festivals, over the years he has mastered a number of truffle dishes which he prepares with homemade traditional Istrian pasta for a real treat for the tastebuds.

Using mostly fresh local ingredients that come bursting with flavour, he also specialises in seafood, saying: "We often organise local fishermen to come to the boat with their fresh catch and let guests choose their own lunch – or even get a lesson in preparing the fish! It's a simple experience, but it's always a special highlight."

He runs a tight galley too, understanding that "cooking techniques, knowledge of ingredients, handling, storing and preparation" are all extremely important, meaning no guest will be left disappointed.

And it's not just about the food for Chef Mario, but the experience as a whole. "For one amazing family we have provided a full Croatian experience with traditional music accompanied with traditional Croatian menu," he smiled.
