THE YACHT

Built by the award winning Turkish shipyard Bilgin Yachts in 2017, Starburst III measures 47.5 metres with a beam of 8.75 metres, a draft of 2.5 metres and a volume of 494 GT. Her exterior design and naval architecture come from local Turkish studio, Unique Yacht Design, and she is surely one of the best condition superyachts on the market, undergoing a two-month refit in 2019 that saw her interior and exterior spaces refreshed, as well as a brand new paint job transforming the yacht to an eyecatching steely grey.

On board, she accommodates up to 10 guests across a five-cabin layout consisting of two VIP staterooms and two twin cabins as well as a generous owner's suite complete with a fold-out balcony on the main deck forward.

When it comes to the menus on board Starburst III, Chef John's dishes vary depending on the seasons, as he likes to work with only the freshest produce available. If you're chartering Starburst III during the summer months, expect plenty of fresh seafood including sautéed red mullet with a cannelloni bean and chorizo salsa, ouzoflambéed calamari with crunchy potato sticks and panfried salmon with courgette risotto and roast fingerling potatoes. Desserts are equally adventurous and might include peach and almond crumble with a coconut crème Anglaise and Eton Mess with balsamic glazed strawberries, among other mouthwatering delights.

An expert in vegetarian cuisine, John's specialities include a caponata ragout on a parmesan sable biscuit, handmade agnolotti pasta filled with courgette, sundried tomatoes and mozzarella, and an apple, walnut, rocket and flageolet bean wellington served with lemon and rosemary baby potatoes and haricot beans.
